Applications are invited for a tenure stream position in **Linguistics and Teaching French as a Second Language** at the rank of Assistant Professor. The appointment will commence on July 1, 2012.

CONTEXT: Glendon College is the bilingual (French-English) liberal arts Faculty of York University. It offers a variety of programs in the humanities and social sciences. It is located on its own separate, mid-town campus.

POSITION: The successful candidate will: be responsible to manage and develop courses and curriculum designed for non-majors of French, in accordance with the principles of the Language Training Centre for Studies in French and set by the bilingual requirements of the College; teach courses and revise language tests; coordinate tutorials for these courses; teach graduate courses and supervise Masters and Doctoral theses and research papers; supervise undergraduate student teaching; collaborate with colleagues across the University on innovative research projects in various branches of Linguistics, such as Sociolinguistics, Psycholinguistics, Applied Linguistics. The successful candidate must be suitable for prompt appointment at the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

CANDIDATES: Candidates must have demonstrated excellence or promise of excellence in teaching and scholarly research in one or more of the following fields: Linguistics and/or Applied Linguistics to the Teaching of French or to Second Language Learning; language assessment, bilingualism, contact of languages and cultures. Given Glendon's bilingual mandate, candidates must be able to participate actively in College-wide activities in both French and English. The successful candidate will have completed a doctorate in a field of study compatible with the advertised position, have demonstrated ability to integrate a variety of pedagogical models and resources in teaching, to initiate, develop and manage research projects in areas related to the advertised position: Second language Acquisition, Second Language learning in a minority setting, language teaching, language testing; have experience in mentorship, and have willingness to join existing research groups including the Centre for Research on Language Contact, and work in collaboration with other researchers.

APPOINTMENT: Initial salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. All positions at York University are subject to budgetary approval.
