It serves 28,000 distinct students through campuses located in Moose Jaw, Prince Albert, Regina and Saskatoon and proudly shares the land located in the homeland of the Metis people on Treaty 4 and Treaty 6 Territory. It also offers an extensive range of distance education opportunities through brokerage arrangements with the province's regional colleges, the Saskatchewan Indian Institute of Technology and the Dumont Technical Institute as well as online education. Associate Dean, School of Nursing

The Associate Dean will ensure program quality, encourage and guide an exceptional team in their commitment to academic integrity and prepare their graduates for success in their field.

Reporting to the Dean, School of Nursing and School of Health Sciences, the Associate Dean will play a major leadership role in positioning the School of Nursing to address the growing demand for educated and qualified individuals in a rapidly growing economy. Based in Regina or Saskatoon, the Associate Dean will lead a team comprised of four academic chairs, nine program heads, two continuing education consultants, a project manager and program development consultant located across the province. The Associate Dean will also develop and foster effective relationships and networks with other schools and departments within Saskatchewan Polytechnic, as well as partnerships with key local, provincial and national stakeholders.

The ideal candidate will have a Master's degree in nursing or in a relevant discipline and a history of applicable leadership and management experience. Eligibility for registration with the CRNS is required. Key to success in this role will be fostering innovation in education delivery, technology, research, efficiencies, and revenue generation as well as developing and leading high-performing teams. Instructional experience in a post-secondary institution is considered an asset.
