Ranked as Canada's top comprehensive university, and with a vision to be Canada's engaged university, Simon Fraser University (SFU) is recognized globally for academic and research excellence. SFU has three vibrant campuses located on the unceded territory of the Coast Salish people in British Columbia's largest municipalities - Burnaby, Surrey and Vancouver - and deep roots in partner communities throughout the province and around the world.

The SFU community includes more than 155,000 alumni, 30,000 undergraduate students, 5,700 graduate students and 2,900 faculty and staff. SFU is consistently ranked among Canada's top 15 research universities by major national and international university ranking systems. We are the first university in British Columbia to be designated an Ashoka U Changemaker Campus, due to our leadership in community engagement and innovation and our deep-seated desire to contribute to meaningful change. Ranked by Maclean's Magazine as the number one comprehensive university in Canada for 10 of the last 11 years, SFU has increased its research capacity more than two-fold over the last 15 years, having surpassed \$100 million in 2013 and reached \$142.6 million in 2018.

Our recognition in academics and research are guided and underpinned by our strong financial foundations, which provide opportunities for growth and development. In 2018, SFU's annual consolidated operating budget was \$750 million, our total financial and non-financial assets were valued at \$1.6 billion, and our endowment capital grew by seven percent.

Built on academic and intellectual freedom, SFU values multi-ethnic diversity, global knowledge and citizenship amongst all of our students, faculty and staff. We honour the history and contribution of Indigenous peoples, cultivate a work environment of recognition and support, and pursue ecological, social and economic sustainability through all programs and operations.

With a passion for higher education and research, the President will be committed to collegiality, collaboration and transparency.
